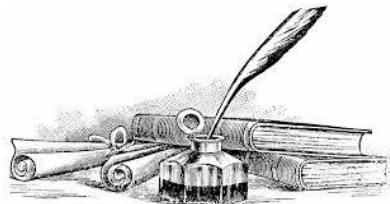
The meeting was adjourned at 8:17 pm.

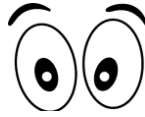

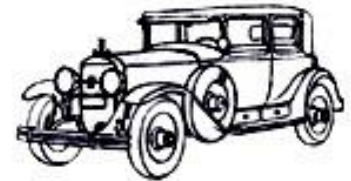

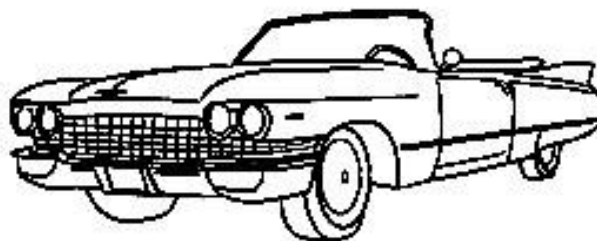
